General Rules for All Leagues

1. Game Time: Major - One Hour Thirty Minutes (1:30)

Minor - One Hour Thirty Minutes (1:30) Rookie - One Hour Fifteen Minutes (1:15)

T-Ball - One Hour Fifteen Minutes (1:15)

- 2. No new inning shall start after the Game Times listed above for each League. (i.e. 1.5 hours for Minor/Major and 1 hour for Rookie/T-Ball)
- 3. In All Leagues, there will be a five (5) run limit per inning. In the sixth inning only, there will be eight 8 run limit.
- 4. In the All Leagues, mercy rule: fifteen (15) run lead after three (3) innings or ten (10) run lead after four (4) innings.
- 5. Prior to the start of the first game, the home team manager will have the field in playable condition. Following the last game, both teams will repair the field to a playable condition. Minor and Major Leagues will need to wash off the pitching mounds after each game.
- 6. Each team is responsible to clean **dugout** & **bleachers** after each game.
- 7. The home team is responsible for keeping the official scorebook and operation of the scoreboard. The home team must also enter the final score in the scoring log book located at the concession stand.
- 8. When two teams have a difference of 3 players, the team with the fewest players will automatically be charged an out following the last player in their lineup.

SBA Tiebreakers

We will determine League Champions, first by Winning Percentage then by Head to Head competition. The below steps outline the process we will use.

Winning Percentage:

• Take the number of wins, add a ½ point for each tie, then divide by the number of games to determine a team's winning percentage.

Head to Head:

- If two teams are tied in head to head competition, then we will have a one game playoff to determine the League Champion.
- When multiple teams are involved, we will use the following criteria:
 - 1. All teams must have played the same amount of games against each other. (i.e. Each team has played each other twice.) If not, skip to step 3.
 - 2. One team must have sweep ALL other teams involved, in order to be crowned the League Champion.
 - 3. If no team has sweep ALL other teams, a multi-team playoff will occur. Seeding will be determined by drawing numbers.
